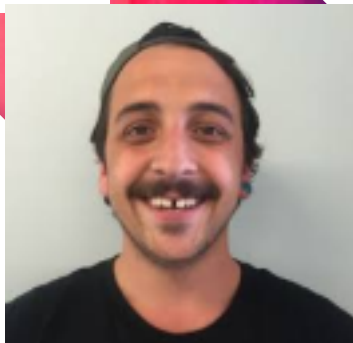

This was the whakatauki/proverb for the day. The day was all about feeding us as leaders to grow and about what we need to grow as a leader

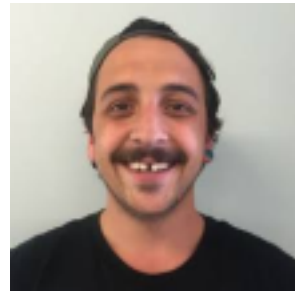
Speakers and hosts



Liz Alexander & Phil Baker

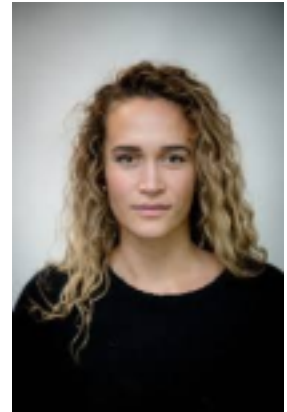
These two were the hosts they introduced the theme and both told us funny stories and played fun games with the crowd.

Christen told us lots of funny stories about accidentally eating dog roll. He told us not to rush and think about thinking.

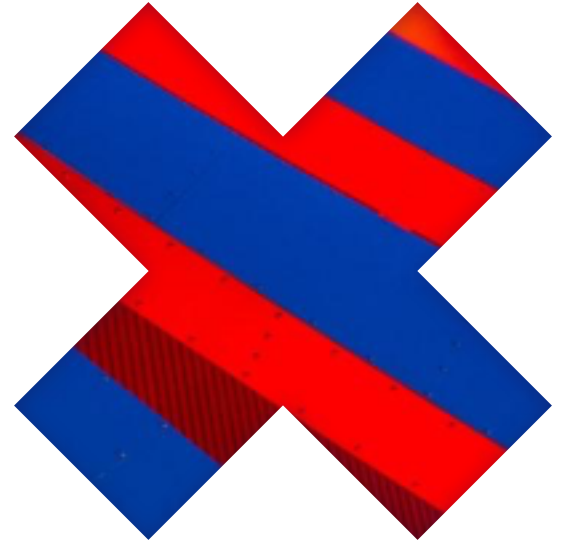


Ronnie Taufalo
