To our Parents, Caregivers and Whānau

I have just finished a hot chocolate after a wet muddy round of outdoor activities, here with our Year 5&6 students at Vertical Horizons. While we are excited to attend the camp planned for earlier this year, it is fantastic to see our students in this environment which is designed to challenge our young people with a range of new experiences.

We hope to host our coastal schools for a Kapahaka event in Week 10 depending on whether we return to COVID Level 1. Omata, Oakura, Rahu and Coastal Schools will come together at Coastal on Thursday 24th of September to share and celebrate what our students have been learning in Kapahaka, creating an opportunity for many students to take the stage and perform for the first time. Our school is fortunate to be trained by Matua Clive Tonga-Awhikau.

Our Year 10 students are planning a Hangi Fundraiser to coincide with the event. Ticket sales are available through an online booking form. Your online banking payment will confirm your ticket purchases.

The ever-changing levels has meant that the inter-school sports and events planned for 2020 have changed. Unfortunately, the Coastal Amazing Race has been cancelled. However, information has been sent home to representatives of our school to compete in the Omata Cross Country if we return to COVID Level 1 next week. It has been great to see our students enjoying and competing in the Saturday Winter Sports Competitions regardless of the challenges the different codes have faced in response to health & safety compliances. Thank you to our parent community for supporting and respecting these limitations.

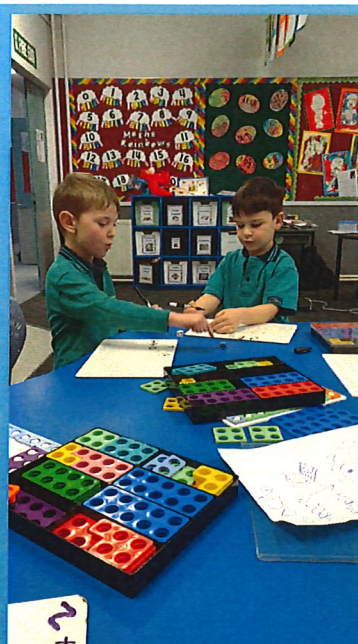
Our internal review of our NCEA students' progress has highlighted a mix of celebrations and concerns. While our staff and school continue to have high expectations and commitment to see each student achieve their potential, we are faced with an NCEA credit counting culture among many students. We have planned and organized to provide further tutoring and support for our NCEA students. This tutoring will be held as an after school gathering as opposed to being built into their timetable as we did last term. Our parents can support at this crucial time by ensuring your children are consistently attending school, managing their timeframes and seeking assistance from our staff as soon as something becomes a challenge and potential barrier to progress.

We were successful with our first of many Urgent Response Funding applications to the MOE. This initial application was for some hours to employ a dedicated attendance person to support the validity of our attendance data, make personalized contact with our families to explain any absence from school and work with whānau and agencies to improve attendance at school. It goes without saying that our students need to be present in order to participate and achieve in their learning.

This week we welcome Mr Behnam Jamnani who is completing a 6 week teaching practicum in our Science Lab with Mrs Barron. It is wonderful to have him contribute to teaching and learning. I join the Year 7&8 science class earlier today and briefly observed a highly engaged and group of learners who were showing manaakitanga to our guest teacher.

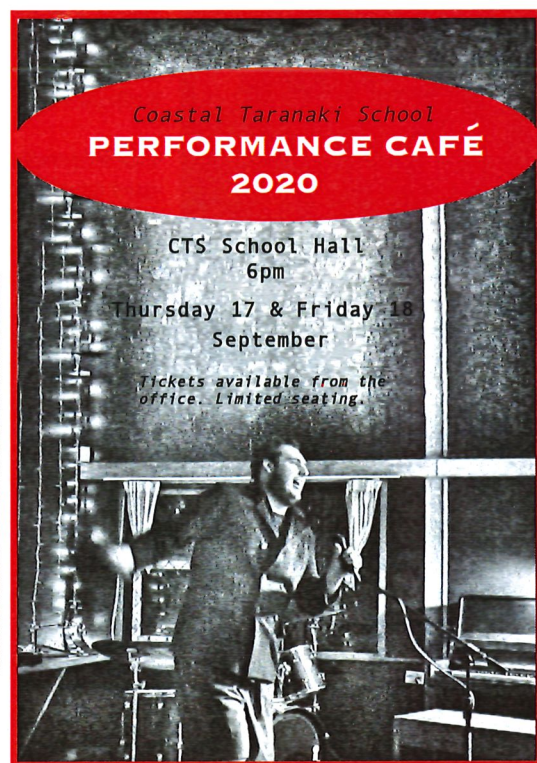
ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES

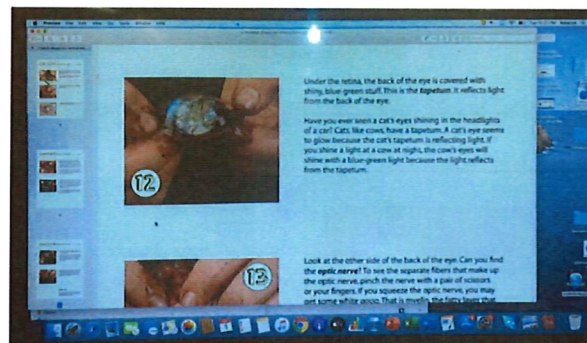
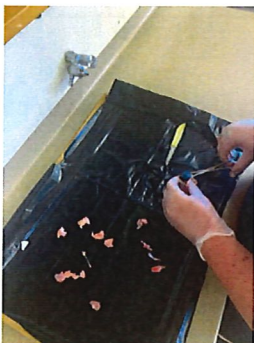
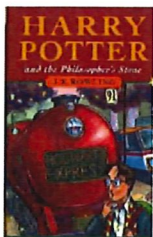
